Assalamu 'alaykum wa rahmatullahi wa barakatuh!*

1. What does tafseer mean?
2. Which four suwar (plural of surah) will we study?
3. The Prophet, salallahu 'alayhi wa sallam, used to dedicate even more time to the .... (fill in the blank) in Ramadan.
4. What was Imam Malik, may Allah have mercy on him, a specialist in?
5. What did Jibreel, alayhis salam, and the Prophet Muhammad, salallahu 'alayhi wa sallam, do together each Ramadan?
6. How many times did Jibreel and the Prophet Muhammad revise the Qur'an in the last Ramadan of the Prophet's life?
7. How many Ramadans did the Prophet, salallahu 'alayhi wa sallam, fast?
8. Tafseer means an explanation of the ayaat of the Qur'an; and sometimes we learn why a certain Surah was revealed. Sometimes ayaat were revealed because people asked about something. Can you name a few examples of things people asked about and Allah, subhanahu wa ta'ala, answered to by revealing ayaat?
9. Surah Al Kaafiroon was revealed after the Quraysh wanted to make a deal with the Prophet, salallahu alayhi wa sallam, which deal did they want to make?
10. In Surah Al Kaafiroon Allah, subhananu wa ta'ala, is telling the Prophet what to say to the Quraysh; can you write down the translation of the Surah?
11. Can idols do anything for us; can they help us, hear or see us?
12. In Surah Al Kaafiroon the ayaat seem to be repeated, can you explain why? What is the difference between the ayaat that seem similar?
13. Allah, subhanahu wa ta'ala, says: lakum deenukum wa liya deen – for you all is your religion and for me is my religion. The truth is the truth, falsehood is falsehood. In Islam right is right, wrong is wrong and you should never mix the right with the wrong. Can you name an example of mixing right and wrong?
14. If Shaytan can't make you stop doing what is right; he will try to make you mix right and wrong. Can you name an example of when it happened to you that someone tried to make you mix right and wrong?
15. If people try to make you mix right and wrong, which ayah of Surah Al Kaafiroon can you use as a

reply?

16. Should you mix right and wrong at school, but just not at home, or where your parents can see you?

17. Allah, subhanahu wa ta'ala, says in the Qur'an that if we follow the Prophet Muhammad, salallahu alayhi wa sallam, we get two things, what are these?

18. Whose Sunnah do we follow?
