### Practise Questions Part 3: Tafseer Suratal Falaq

1. Which suwar (plural of surah) do we call the '4 Qul's' and why are the '4 Qul's' called like this?
2. Of the four Qul's, three are together and one is separate; which three are together in the Qur'an and which one is separate?
3. What did some scholars describe as a reason why one of the Qul's is separate?
4. Surah al Falaq is a shield as well as a weapon, can you explain this?
5. Allah, subhanahu wa ta'ala, made different suwar in the Qur'an a protection for us, so when you recite them, evil parts of the creation get scared. Just like you have good people, you have bad people and just like you have good jinns, there are bad jinns. Can Surah al Falaq be a protection against all of them?
6. Sometimes bad people get together with bad jinn, to do what?
7. Allah, subhanahu wa ta'ala, called the whole Qur'an a cure; does Shaytan like the Qur'an?
8. The Prophet, salallahu 'alayhi wa sallam, taught us how to be protected from shaytan, magic, bad people, jinns etc. The Prophet taught us to read Surah Al Falaq at certain moments of the day so you will be protected, when is it sunnah to read Surah Al Falaq?
9. What does Lord mean?
10. What does falaq mean?
11. Who makes the sun rise and who makes the darkness go away in the early part of the morning?
12. Why did Allah, subhanahu wa ta'ala, say the Lord of the Daybreak?
13. There are many dangerous things out there, of which we don't even know they are dangerous! What does Allah, subhanahu wa ta'ala, tell us in the second ayah to seek refuge from?
14. What does Allah, subhanahu wa ta'ala, teach us to seek refuge from in the third ayah?
15. In the fourth ayah, Allah, subhanahu wa ta'ala, tells us to seek refuge from certain types of people. Who?
16. What does 'uqad mean in the fourth ayah?
17. In the last ayah, Allah, subhanahu wa ta'ala, tells us to seek refuge from the 'hasad' of those who have 'hasad'. What is the meaning of 'hasad'?
18. Can you name an example of 'hasad' in your daily life?

*You don't know who is jealous of you, or where the jinns are and what they and bad people are up to, but you can read Surah Al Falaq, Surah Al Ikhlas and Surah An Naas to be protected! And never forget to have*

*trust in Allah's protection when you recite your suwar.*
